Refresher course can only be attended within 3 years of original date of Fire Safety Advisor course, if original course date is outside 3 years the full Fire Safety Advisor course must be done again as per the 'Building Fire Safety Regulation 2008'.

PUAWER001B Identify, prevent and report potential workplace emergency situations

Assessment:

To successfully complete this course the participant will be required to undertake formal assessment activities in addition to providing the following portfolio evidence: • Copy of a fire evacuation plan the participant has worked on. • Copy of a fire evacuation diagram the participant has developed or been involved in the review of. • Copy of the evacuation drill report or training reports including evacuation. • A completed fire safety audit the participant has undertaken. • A risk assessment related to fire safety. Upon successful completion of the course participants will receive a nationally recognised Statement of Attainment.

Delivery Method:

Training will be delivered within a public training facility utilising theory and practical activities. Delivery will include instructor led presentations / scenarios.
